

Life in our Bentley or Maggie rooms

Little ones in our Bentley room are generally aged from 16 to 24 months, and in our Maggie room from 24 months to 3 years. At times we may suggest that a child remains in the Bentley room until they are 3 years if we feel this would benefit the child's individual developmental needs.

We offer a flexible day-to-day routine in order to support a child-led learning environment. We also work with each individual family to accommodate their wishes as far as possible with regards to home routine, feeding habits and sleep patterns.

An example of a typical day in a Bentley or Maggie room

8:00 to 8:30am	Free play while we welcome little ones as they arrive for the day
8.45 to 9.15am	Breakfast is served
9.30 to 10.15am	Maggie & Rose class activities (alongside care routines)
10.30 to 10.45am	Morning snack
10.45 to 11.15am	Circle time
11.15am to 12pm	Garden time
12 to 12.30pm	Lunch is served
12.15 to 1pm	Children who are with us solely for the morning session take part in planned activities and enjoy story time until home time. Full time children may be offered a short nap if appropriate
1 to 1.15pm	Home time for our morning children and we welcome little ones who attend the afternoon session as they arrive
1.30 to 2.15pm	Maggie & Rose class activities (alongside care routines)
2.30 to 2.45pm	Afternoon snack
3 to 3.30pm	Garden time
3.30 to 4.30pm	Maggie & Rose class activities
4.30 to 4.45pm	Tea is served
4.45 to 5.15pm	Circle time
5.15 to 6pm	Free play while we say goodbye to little ones as they're collected to go home.
