

Life in our Oscar room

Little ones in our Oscar room are generally aged from 3 to 6 months to 16 months. At times we may suggest that a little one remains in the Oscar room until up to 24 months if we feel this would benefit the little one's individual developmental needs.

We offer a flexible day-to-day routine in order to support a child-led learning environment. We also work with each individual family to accommodate their wishes as far as possible with regards to home routine, feeding habits and sleep patterns.



An example of a typical day in our Oscar room

8:00 to 8:30am	Free play while we welcome little ones as they arrive for the day
8.45 to 9.15am	Breakfast is served
9.30 to 10.15am	Garden time
10.30 to 10.45am	Morning snack
10.45 to 11.15am	Planned activities (alongside care routines)
11.15am to 11:30pm	Circle time
11.30am to 12pm	Lunch is served
12.15 to 1pm	Those little ones who are with us for a full day go to sleep. Little ones who are with us solely for the morning session take part in planned activities and enjoy story time until home time
1 to 1.15pm	Home time for our morning children and we welcome little ones who attend the afternoon session as they arrive
1.30 to 2.15pm	Planned activities (alongside care routines)
2.30 to 2.45pm	Afternoon snack
3 to 3.30pm	Music and movement session
3.30 to 4.30pm	Garden time
4.30 to 4.45pm	Tea is served
4.45 to 5.15pm	Circle time
5.15 to 6pm	Free play while we say goodbye to little ones as they're collected to go home.
